## Duties of Riverside Metropolitan Museum (RMM):

City Advertising: creation of materials and circulation - we just need to advertise around campus with flyers, scottmail email announcements, and on social media (Amelia). Event Planning: entertainers (bug chef, Dr. Zoolittle, MC, stage games, butterfly tent, face painting, balloons, etc.), vendors (paid, supporters, and all organization/questions), food tents/trucks, and supplies (decorations, tables, chairs, stage, set-up/clean-up).
