### Entomology Research Museum – Krissy Dominguez

- The Entomology Research Museum staff will be offering a full day free workshop on insect mounting and labeling techniques. The workshop will be held at the Entomology Research Museum on Thursday, 30 November 2017. In the morning (9:00 AM to 11:30 AM), we will provide advice and hands-on experience in specimen preparation (including critical point drying/HMDS from ethanol, pinning, spreading, and point mounting) of different groups of insects, and labeling. We encourage you to bring with you any prepared voucher specimens that you would like to deposit in the ERM collection. In the afternoon (1:00 PM to 4:00 PM), Serguei Triapitsyn and Vladimir Berezovskiy, Principal Museum Preparator Emeritus, will show how to prepare high quality microscopic slides in Canada balsam. This part of the workshop is optional and restricted to at most 4-5 participants due to space limitations, so please let us know beforehand if you would like to attend.
